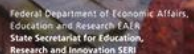

The meeting room in Building L is located to **the left of the main entrance** of the campus. Direction signs to the workshop venue will be available on-site.

Travelling to Ghent

✈ By Plane

Ghent is conveniently connected to Belgium's main airports:

Brussels Airport (BRU)

Ghent lies some **40 km west** of Brussels Airport.

On arrival at Brussels Airport:

- take a **direct train to Ghent** (*approx. 1 hour*); or
- take a train towards Brussels and change for Ghent at:
 - Brussels North
 - Brussels Central
 - Brussels South (Midi)

From these stations, take the IC train towards:

- Ostend
- Knokke-Blankenberge
- De Panne

and exit at **Ghent Sint-Pieters** station.

(*travel time from Brussels: approx. 35 minutes*)

Travelling to Ghent

By Plane

Brussels South Charleroi Airport (CRL)

Ghent lies approximately **70 km** from Charleroi Airport.

From Charleroi Airport:

- take a bus to **Charleroi Station**
- continue by train to **Brussels South (Midi)**
- change there for a train to **Ghent Sint-Pieters**

From Brussels South, take the IC train towards:

- Ostend
- Knokke-Blankenberge
- De Panne

and exit at **Ghent Sint-Pieters** station.

(travel time from Brussels: approx. 35 minutes)

By Train or Bus

Ghent is easily accessible from neighbouring countries via international rail connections. International coach services (e.g. FlixBus, Eurolines) also connect Ghent with several European cities, typically stopping at:

- Ghent Sint-Pieters Station
 - Ghent Dampoort Station

Local Transport in Ghent

Ghent has an efficient public transport network operated by De Lijn.

Tickets may be purchased:

- via ticket machines
- through the De Lijn mobile app
- by SMS
- directly on board using a contactless bank card

A standard ticket (€3) is valid for 60 minutes. Day passes are also available.

Please remember to validate your ticket when boarding.

From Ghent Sint-Pieters Station to the Venue

Take:

- Tram Line 4 towards *Lange Steenstraat*

Exit at:

- Rabot stop

Approximate travel time:

- 15 minutes
